May 24 Neartown Superneighborhood (20 neighborhoods, including Cherryhurst)
Review and discuss additional plans for action.

Thursday 6:30pm Cherryhurst Park near the Community Center Building*
May 26 Cherryhurst Civic Association Meeting will establish plans for action.

NOTE: If the Cherryhurst Park Community Center Building is available, these meetings will be inside. In case of rain, look for a notice with meeting location a block away.
